New Curriculum of Summer Fun & Learning!

Session 1 (enrollment weeks 1 & 2): Dawg Days of Summer

During this session we will focus on our community. We will visit places local to Montlake (UW, local shops, parks) so that we can get to know the people and places close to us. We will spend time reaching out to our community as well by having a car wash, doing neighborhood clean up and much more.

Field Trips: Burke Museum, WAC climbing wall, Volunteer Park, Cal Anderson Park, Greenlake, University of Washington, and Medgar Evers Pool. **Activities:** Community Building, Mural Creation, Car Wash, Lemonade Stand, and Neighborhood Clean-up.

Session 2 (enrollment weeks 3 & 4): Discovery Days

During this session we will be out and about visiting local farmers markets and gardens around the city. We will spend time learning how to plant our own garden, how to compost to provide fuel for our garden and why recycling and composting is so important for our environment.

Field Trips: Seattle Tilth, local farmers markets, Pike Place market, Marra Farm, Children's Garden at Magnuson Park, and Medgar Evers Pool. **Activities:** Garden planting, creating our own greenhouse with vegetables, salad journey, fresh fruit/veggie cooking projects, and making our own worm/compost bin.

Session 3 (enrollment weeks 5 & 6): Pirates on Parade

During this session we will transform Montlake CDSA into a Pirates Cove! ARG! We will spend time learning about pirates and building our own pirate ship (float) to set sail into the mighty ocean! (Lake Washington) We will visit Alki beach and participate in some of the Seafair activities that are going on in Seattle.

Field Trips: Seafair, Alki, Center for Wooden Boats, Local Parks, Arboretum, Medgar Evers Pool, and Ride the DUCK Seattle! **Activities:** Peter Pan play, costume making, pirate ship creation, capture the loot (flag), buried treasure/beach combing.

Session 4 (enrollment weeks 7 & 8): Wild Water World!

During this session, we will be totally focused on water activities! We will learn about different types of places to visit that have water, water safety with CPR practice. We will also do some marina exploration and learn about marine ecosystems around the Puget Sound.

Field Trips: Greenlake, Alki, Lake Washington, Ballard Locks, Seattle Aquarium, beach combing, the Seattle fountain and Medgar Evers Pool. **Activities:** Eco system (circle of life) projects, water safety exploration, and beach collages with collected items.

Session 5 (enrollment weeks 9 & 10): Lights, Camera, Action!

During this session, we will be bringing out our creative side! It is the last few weeks of summer, so we want to make it count!

Field Trips: Local parks—for live music, Seattle Children's Theater, Northwest Film Forum, Northwest puppet theater. **Activities:** Movie making, pictures collages, THE BIG SHOW! Photography, and end of summer carnival.
